

## Minutes of IPPG Meeting held at the Health Centre on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019

Minutes of the meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> June were signed.

DNA's June were 67 (3 doctor's hours lost). DNA figures not on TV screen – DMC to correct system.

Signpost leaflets printed and awaiting lamination.

Open Day: Proposed date – end of August; PPG attendance requested; possible subjects – Diabetes/Hayfever.

BP donations: Cllr R Clark has pledged £500; Cllr C Woodford may pledge similar amount; IPPG pledged £50 (*action Pamela*); Puzzle corner has raised £28 to date. Propose asking Kent Cllr. M Whiting and DMC towards £1500 total.

Website is receiving more hits and greater approval of content.

New clinics: Doctor's Fri.7-8.00am, HCA's Tues. 7.30-8.00am and Fri. 7.30-8am. GP and Paul H. have found walk-in bus clinic very helpful (35-40 PXs seen each day).

First Aid Course: Fully booked (11-12 persons) 18<sup>th</sup> July; Liz to confirm 'Annie' available.

Car parking: GP held helpful meeting with Cllrs. Clark and Woodford. Appears that land was allocated for health centre parking in general plan but Persimmons have ignored this and now sold on the land. Land is likely to be transferred back to Swale under 106 agreement but not for the next 2 years. Who will pay for creating car park is not yet clear (perhaps a combination of Swale, DMC and CCG?). This still work in progress.

New IPPG member: Tracy Smith, chiropodist and former midwife, wiling to join after school holidays. Proposed Pamela and agreed. Coffee morning to introduce her proposed by Pamela. Second suggested new member thought to be unsuitable.

AOB: Uniforms delayed as supplier has gone out of business; Name badges ordered.
